### Dear Families,

As I write this newsletter, I am listening to the samba rhythms and watching the carnival dance practice through my window. There is something about the sound of the music and the sound of the children laughing and enjoying themselves that can't help but make you smile. This is all in preparation for the Hale Carnival that is due to take place on Saturday 6th July. We would love our families to join in the procession - more information is included below.

This week has seen our Governors come in to the Academy to monitor the quality of education. They have met with a range of children across all year groups and have spoken to them about all their learning throughout the year. The children have given their honest views and have spoken eloquently about the foundation subjects they have enjoyed the most. History and Science are definitely coming across as their favourites so far, with Art and DT close behind. As part of this monitoring, both the staff and the children have had the chance to openly discuss the behaviour policy with Mr Ayre and raise any concerns they may have. Next week on Thursday 4th, we have our Quality of Education visit from the Trust, where our Executive Head and other Trust Leaders will be with us for the day to see lessons in action and once again speak to the children and staff about their learning.

I have been taking several visitors around the school this week and they have made many compliments about our incredibly polite, well-mannered and well-behaved children. Each and everyone of them has done us proud.

On Wednesday 26th June children from across years 2-4 went across to the Grove Academy and took part in the Kite Times Tables Championships. We are very proud of our children who put themselves forward to take part. Please see the article below for how they all got on.





## Family Support Worker Come & Ask session

Do you need help with sleep routines or fussy eaters? Is your child showing signs of anxiety or challenging behaviour? Is there a specific area around home life and meeting your child's needs you would like some support with? Maybe you just need reassurance that you are doing the best for your child. This is the perfect opportunity to have an informal conversation with a Family Support Worker from our Trust.

#### Come & Ask sessions

Our Kite Family Support Workers will be holding Come & Ask sessions fortnightly during the Autumn term. One-hour appointments are available every other Thursday morning between 9:00am and 1:30pm. During the Come & Ask session, you will have the opportunity to share what the concern is, discuss it and look at ways to address the situation.
