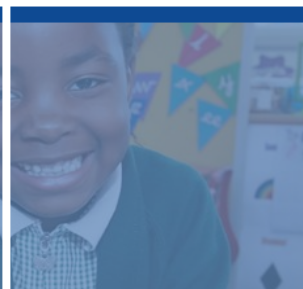

Record achievement!

The Ferns Primary Academy achieves its first good Ofsted gradings in all areas.

In the school's **25 year history**, The Ferns Primary Academy had never been judged as better than inadequate, requires improvement or satisfactory overall. Following an inadequate judgement just 2 years ago, we could not be prouder of the remarkable transformation at The Ferns which has led to the academy being judged as **good** in all areas in October 2024.

The Ofsted Inspector observed the high expectations for behaviour and learning at The Ferns, which children rise to and, as a result, feel **happy and safe at school**. It is a delight to see recognition given to the respectful behaviour that now permeates throughout The Ferns and enables pupils to focus on learning without any distractions, listen well and work hard.

We are particularly proud that the broad and ambitious Kite curriculum was recognised, along with high aspirations for all pupils, both of which are making a real difference to pupils' learning and lives. **Our wonderful pupils at The Ferns embody our core values and demonstrate positive attitudes to learning, determination and perseverance to be successful.**

What our Kite team at The Ferns, and colleagues from across the Trust, have achieved for the pupils and the wider community, in such a short space of time, is quite simply exceptional! Stripey Stork strives to support as many families as possible with supplies to ensure that all children are ready for school, such as:

- non-logoed school uniform
- school bags
- PE kit and trainers
- school shoes
- coats
- stationery
- items for school residential or trips.

Other essential items are also available, such as cots, bedding, buggies, stairgates, toys, books, toiletries, clothing and shoes for babies and children aged 0 - 18 years.

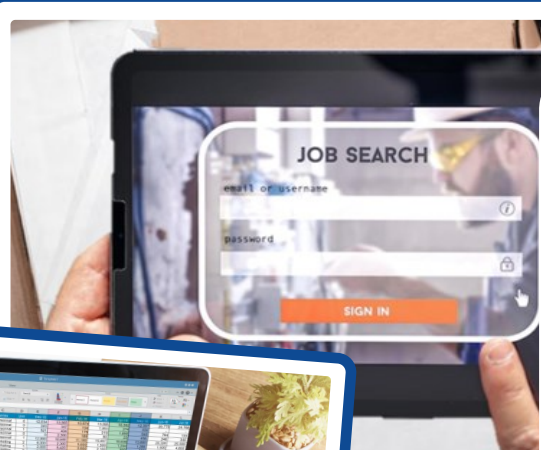
Kite Stronger Communities Week

Our Estates team are also sharing their skills with the community, including collaborating with Surrey County Council to monitor air quality around The Grove Primary Academy.

The team have worked to clear grounds at Hale Community Centre and will be supporting St Peters Church in Frimley with their grounds maintenance.

The team also re-homed a piano that was no longer useable at Sandringham, delivering it to a local assisted living complex, which the residents were delighted to receive.



Our IT Team are currently implementing an initiative to repurpose older laptops and iPads, by fully refurbishing these devices to make them available for you, our Kite community.

While their classroom days may be over, these devices are perfect for everyday tasks such as web browsing, internet banking, creating documents and more!

Estates Projects

We are proud to share with you an update on a number of Estates projects that have been completed across the Trust this academic year, supported at every stage by our fantastic Kite Estates Team.



At Holly Lodge, as part of a fully funded initiative, this year we have completed a new classroom build for Year 4 and opened an extended and refurbished office space for our Kite Business Services Teams.

We are delighted to have had the opportunity to provide these new learning environments for our pupils, as well as a dedicated work space for our superb Business Services colleagues.



As many of you will be aware from the news, there has been a national focus in recent years on identifying and remediating RAAC (reinforced autoclaved aerated concrete) in many public buildings. At The Grove, after swift identification by our Estates Team and a close-working partnership with the Department for Education, we are delighted to have successfully completed the extensive remediation project and re-opened the affected areas of the academy for our pupils.
