Year 6 Bike Training 2026

As part of our Year 6 enrichment programme, we are pleased to offer all pupils the opportunity to take part in cycle training tailored to their ability.

This term, all Year 6 children will attend the **Bikeability "Try-it-out" day** running on the 3 February, delivered by Surrey County Council. During this short session, children will receive basic cycling tuition appropriate for their cycling skills and have a ride on one of Active Surrey's pool bikes. If your child has a bike they would like to use for the training, they are welcome to bring it in for the instructors to check it over in advance of the Bikeability Level 2 course.

Following the Try-it-out day, children will be invited to either:

Learn to Ride training – for those still developing their cycling skills (4 and 5 February) **Bikeability Level 2** – for those ready to cycle on local roads with moderate traffic (w/c 23 February and w/c 2 March)

Bikeability Level 2 equips children with the skills and confidence to ride independently and safely, focusing on four core areas: observation, communication, positioning, and priorities.

- All training is free of charge
- Pool bikes are available for children who do not have access to their own
- Training is delivered by qualified instructors in a risk-assessed area near the school
