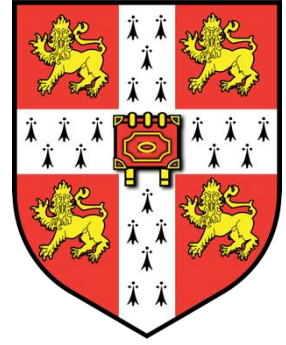


Dear Cambridge Class,
